	<p>Albizia Summer Chocolate Fern-like warm chocolate-coloured foliage. Pink, fluffy flower heads in late summer on mature plants.</p>
	<p>Abelia x grand.Kaleidoscope® Striking new compact form. Bright cream/yellow variegation changes to orange & red in autumn.</p>
	<p>Artemisia Powis Castle Spreading compact evergreen with aromatic foliage. Prefers well-drained soil and dry sunny sites.</p>
	<p>Aucuba japonica Variegata Evergreen shrub. Grows on most soils. Red berries when pollinated. Pollution and shade tolerant.</p>
	<p>Cercis Hearts of Gold Leaves emerge red turning bright gold. Lavender purple flowers on stems in spring. Full sun/part shade</p>
	<p>Choisya ternate Sundance ('Lich') Golden foliage all year. Fragrant white flowers. PBR APPLIES. NO UNAUTHORISED PROPAGATION.</p>
	<p>Choisya White Dazzler (Londaz) Small evergreen shrub, aromatic leaves. fragrant, white flowers early spring and again in autumn. Ht 1.5m</p>
	<p>Coprosma Pacific Night ('Hutwow') An evergreen native of New Zealand. Raised by Graham Hutchins of County Park Nurseries, Essex an expert in New Zealand plants. Considered to be the hardiest Coprosma.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evergreen rich purple / black foliage, at its most intense in spring and autumn • Neat upright habit and year-round interest make it ideal for container gardening • Drought tolerant once established. Hardy to -5° <p>Eventual Height and spread 1.5x1.5m</p>
	<p>Coprosma Pacific Sunset ('JWNCOPPS') Found as a sport of the top-selling Coprosma Pacific Night at John Woods Nurseries. New to the market in 2010. Winner at IPM 2010 - Patio Plant Innovation Striking evergreen variegated foliage. Neat upright habit and year-round interest make it ideal for container gardening. Drought tolerant once established. Hardy to -5°</p> <p>Eventual Height and spread 1.5x1.5m</p>



	<p>Cornus x Kousa Celestial Shadow Sport of Celestial. Variegated leaves with wide golden border, turning orange/red in Autumn. 8m</p>
	<p>Cornus alba Spaethii Deciduous shrub. Golden variegated leaves. Bright red stems. Tolerates most soils incl. waterlogged.</p>
	<p>Corylus avellana Red Majestic Attractive purple foliage, with heavily twisted, contorted stems. Most soils in sun or shade.</p>
	<p>Diervilla Cool Splash ('LPDCPODASA') Another member of the First Editions range, the US-developed Cool Splash™ is perfect for brightening up those dry shady spots. The eye-catching, crisp white variegation thrives in dry shade and is also happy in full sun. A densely-branched deciduous shrub closely related to Weigela, Diervilla sessilifolia Cool Splash™ is hardy, easy to grow and keeps its clean fresh variegation well into autumn. Tiny yellow flowers in late May/June. Height and spread 1m x 1m</p>
	<p>Eucalyptus gunni Cedar Gum' Evergreen shrub; rounded, silver-blue young foliage turning to sickle-shaped grey-green later</p>
	<p>Euonymus fort.Blondy[Interbolwi] Dark green leaves with golden splashes. PBR APPLIES/NO UNAUTH PROP.</p>
	<p>Helichrysum itali.Korma[Proma] Dwarf, felty silver-grey leaves, slight aroma, intense silver in summer. PBR APPLIES. NO UNAUTH PROP.</p>
	<p>Hydrangea Bombshell Compact new paniculata hybrid, extremely free-flowering over a long period. Easy to care for and ideal for the front of a border. Hardy to – 20C Height and spread 1 x 1m</p>



	<p>Hydrangea Endless Summer® 'The Bride' Flowers throughout the summer, year after year Ideal for patio pots, beds and borders. Good for cut flower decoration, pure white flowers with a hint of blush. Easy to grow in a well drained soil in sun or partial shade</p> <p>Height and spread 1-1.5m (3-5ft)</p>
	<p>Koelreuteria pan.Coral Sunset Coral pink leaves in spring fading to green, Good autumn colour. PBR APPLIES/NO UNAUTH PROP.</p>
	<p>Lavatera x clem. Barnsley 'Mallow'. Shrubby plant with hollyhock-like flowers of pale pink, dark centres, Jun-Oct. Good soil, sun.</p>
	<p>Lavandula ang. Hidcote Silvery foliage provides contrast to deepest purple blue flowers. Dwarf compact habit. 30x45cms.</p>
	<p>Leycesteria formosa Golden Lanterns (Notbruce) Compact. Arching stems, bright golden foliage, burgundy flowers. Full sun. PBR APPLIES. NO UNAUTH PROP.</p>
	<p>Physocarpus Little Devil™ (Donna May PPAF0) Bred in the USA by David Zlesak, this a compact opulus form. Rich plum-purple foliage acts as a great foil to shrubs and perennials. White-pink button like blooms in June. Hardy to -30C</p> <p>Height and spread: 90 x 90cm</p>
	<p>Pittosporum ternata Silver Queen Silvery-grey, leaves narrowly margined with white. Forms a neat shrub. Avoid exposed sites.</p>
	<p>Rhus Tiger Eyes (Balitiger) Deeply cut golden green leaves turn bright red/orange and intense scarlet in autumn.</p> <p>Height and spread 2 x2m</p>
	<p>Robinia 'Lace Lady ' A mini tree with year round interest Attractive curled foliage on unusual zig-zagged branches Prefers a well-drained soil in a sheltered sunny site A good choice for patio pots Height and spread 2.5x2.5m (8x8ft) approx in 10 years</p>



	<p>Rosemarinus off. Roman Beauty Compact arching stems that make a mound of fresh green foliage, Dark blue flowers in May</p>
	<p>Sambucus Black Lace (Eva) The finely cut purple foliage of this fast reliable easy to grow shrub looks really special. The attractive pink flowers and edible fruit all add to the interest.</p> <p>Height and spread 3 x 2m</p>
	<p>Sambucus rac. Sutherland Gold Deciduous shrub. Golden foliage. White flowers in May. Red berries. Most soils.</p>
	<p>Santolina Lemon Fizz New form of 'cotton lavender' Bright golden foliage, all year around, at its brightest in spring. Ideal for container gardening and creating contrast in a border and has a typical yellow Santolina flower. Drought tolerant once established.</p>
	<p>Yucca fil. Bright Edge Evergreen. Upright panicles of cream flowers Jul-Aug. Stemless. Architectural plant. Hot, dry site.</p>

	<p>Acer palm. Seiryu Upright habit. Finely-cut leaves bright green, tinged red when young. Orange-yellow in autumn.</p>
	<p>Acer palm. Reticulata Red Leaves are maroon in spring, green cream pink in summer and orange red in autumn. height 3-4m</p>
	<p>Acer palm. Linearolobum Leaves bright green with yellow and red in early spring – turning darker later.</p>
	<p>Catalpa bignoniodes Aurea Large deciduous shrub/tree. A golden form with coppery new leaves that unfurl to gleaming yellow in May. White flowers Jul-Aug. Avoid exposed sites RHS AGM</p> <p>Height and spread: 9 x9m</p>

	<p>Rose Joie de Vivre (Korfloc01) Voted Rose of the Year 2011 by the UK's leading rose experts; named to celebrate the joy of life this is a beautiful variety with a nostalgic flower shape and gentle fragrance. Joie de Vivre blooms throughout the summer year after year, and its compact habit and glossy green foliage make it a great choice for patio pots.</p>

	<p>Astelia banksii A flax-like, silver-green, strappy leaves.1-2m long. Greenish flowers followed by purple fruit.</p>
	<p>Astilbe Ellie Pure white flowers over dark green foliage in early to mid summer.</p>
	<p>Astrantia major Ruby Star Dark red flowerheads with black-tipped bracts Jun-Aug. Sun/Part-Shade, moist, drained soil.</p>
	<p>Astrantia major Super Star Clump forming perennial. Stunning star-shaped white flowers with green tips. Moist soil.</p>
	<p>Brunnera Jack Frost A perennial with a long season of interest for a shady spot Large heart-shaped leaves laced silver and green Produces sprays of forget-me-knot blue flowers in spring Best in a moist well drained soil in partial shade Height and spread 30x45cm (12x18ins)</p>
	<p>Cosmos Chocca Mocca Rich coloured blooms, chocolate fragrance. Easy to grow Likes well drained soil Attracts bees and butterflies Height and spread 60cm</p>

	<p>Eremurus Isabel. Ruiter Hybrids Clump forming fleshy perennial Spikes of shell pink to orange flowers mid summer Ideal for cut flowers, striking garden plant Mid green leaves Grow in well drained soil in full sun Height 125cm</p>
	<p>Gerbera Everlast White Hardy perennial, Creamy-white flowers with lemon yellow eye. April/July. 35x30cm. PBR APPLES.</p>
	<p>Hemerocallis Stella de Oro Stocky clump of grassy green leaves with golden, bell shaped flowers and orange throat Jun-Oct. 40cm.</p>
	<p>Heuchera Lime Marmalade Clump forming. Lime green ruffled chartreuse foliage. white flowers. Part shade 25x40cm PBR APPLIES</p>
	<p>Heuchera Marmalade Clump forming perennial, orange-red leaves, reddish bell shaped blooms 35x45cm PBR APPLIES/NO UNAUTH PROP</p>
	<p>Heuchera Midnight Rose Long season of interest and ideal for patio pots An evergreen with a neat mound forming habit Black leaves densely spotted pink in spring Easy to grow best in well drained soil in partial shade Height 25cm</p>
	<p>Heuchera Obsidian Long season of interest and ideal for patio pots An evergreen with a neat mound forming habit Dainty sprays of white flowers from June to August Easy to grow best in well drained soil in partial shade Height 25x40cm (10x16ins)</p>
	<p>Hosta June Variegated form of `Halcyon'. Leaves yellow/green, prominent veining. PBR APPLIES,NO UNAUTH PROP.</p>
	<p>Hosta Patriot Forms clumps of broad strikingly variegated foliage Funnel shaped lavender blue flowers in summer Olive green leaves with white margins Likes moist humus-rich soil in sun or shade Height 55cm</p>
	<p>Hosta fort.Albomarginata Mid-deep green leaves with irregular cream margins turning white with age. Fertile, moist soil. Ht 55cm.</p>

	<p>Knautia Mars Midget</p> <p>Attractive clump forming perennial with many red flowers Ruby red flowers produced from early summer to autumn Fresh green attractive leaves create a dense matt Easy to grow year after year Height and spread 40x30cm (16x12ins)</p>
	<p>Leucanthemum xsuperbum Aglaia Shasta Daisy' Robust clump-former. Dark leaves. White, fringed, semi double flowers Jun-Aug. Ht 60cm.</p>
	<p>Libertia ixio.Goldfinger Small evergreen plant with golden sword shaped leaves.Hardy and versatile</p>
	<p>Lilium formo. v. pricei Elegant dwarf lily with slender, fragrant trumpet shaped white flowers, flushed purple outside. 30x15cm</p>
	<p>Nepeta Six Hills Giant An evergreen perennial that flowers year after year. Spikes of lavender blue flowers throughout the summer. Attractive aromatic grey green foliage and thrives in a sunny spot with a well drained soil.</p> <p>Height and spread 90x90cm</p>
	<p>Ophiopogon plan Nigrescens Ideal for patio pots or the front of a border. Easy to grow evergreen with all year round interest and delicate pink flowers in summer followed by black berries. Prefers a moist well drained soil in sun or partial shade.</p> <p>Height 20cm with a slow spreading habit</p>
	<p>Penstemon Garnet Evergreen. Not fully hardy. Spikes of deep red tubular flowers all summer. Sheltered site/good soil/sun.</p>
	<p>Penstemon Vesuvius (Yasius) Brightly coloured spikes are purple with a white throat. Upright and bushy habit. Ht 70 - 80 cms.</p>
	<p>Potentilla Gold Sovereign Clump forming perennial with large yellow flowers on soft dense foliage.</p>
	<p>Rudbeckia Berlin Yellow flowers with brown-red centre from June-September. 65cm</p>
	<p>Rudbeckia Dublin Bright orange-yellow flowers from June till September. 65cm</p>
	<p>Rudbeckia Peking Yellow-orange petals flushed purple-brown towards 'eye'. Flowers June-September. 65cm</p>

	<p>Sedum Angelina Vigorous and hardy. Golden yellow succulent foliage takes on attractive orange tints in cold weather. Good ground cover plant.</p> <p>Height 10-15cm</p>
	<p>Tulbaghia violacea Silver Lace Clumping perennial. Cream striped leaves. Umbels of lilac, fragrant flowers mid-summer.</p>
	<p>Verbascum Primrose Path Compact form with pretty flower spikes of primrose, over grey green foliage.</p>
	<p>Verbena bonariensis Excellent for providing height in a perennial border. Tall stems bearing rose lavender flower heads in summer. Half hardy and prefers well drained fertile soil in full sun</p> <p>Height and spread: 120 x 60cm</p>
	<p>Verbena rigida Fast growing perennial. Purple flowers in summer Dark green foliage in summer Grow in moist well drained soil Height 15-30cm</p>
	<p>X Heucherella Stoplight Yellow leaves with red centres', dainty flowers, shade. 15cm PBR APPLIES NO UNAUTH PROP</p>

<p><u>Ferns/Grasses</u></p>	
	<p>Carex oshimensis Everest Hardy Japanese sedge. Narrow arching cream & green striped leaves. 30cm.</p>
	<p>Carex oshimensis Evergold Hardy Japanese sedge. A rounded clump of narrow arching yellow & green banded leaves. Ht 20cm.</p>
	<p>Carex flagellifera Clump forming perennial. Green/reddish brown leaves/light brown flowers. Most soils/sun/part shade.</p>
	<p>Dryopteris felix mas Male Fern. Semi-evergreen hardy fern with arching, lance-shaped fronds. Moist soil. Shade. 1-1.5m.</p>
	<p>Dryopteris aff. Crista (The King) Elegantly crested, arching extremely adaptable fern, Dry shade. 100cm.</p>
	<p>Festuca glauca Elijah Blue Bright blue bladed grass. Neat mounds with blue/green</p>

	flowers May/June. 15cm.Sun/semi-shade.
	<p>Hakonechloa macra Alboaura Soft clumps of graceful, ribbon like leaves vividly variegated gold and buff with traces of bronze. Best colour in full sun, ideal for patio containers. RHS AGM Height & spread: 25 x 40cm</p>
	<p>Stipia tenuissima Clump forming grass, with very thin leaves and silvery looking flower/seed heads that blow in wind</p>
	<p>Uncinia Everflame (Belinda's Find) Compact mounding habit. Deep red leaves attractively striped cherry red. 25x25cm</p>

<u>Hedging</u>	
	<p>Box hedging Evergreen ideal for edging. RHS AGM Height: 10m</p>
	<p>Hornbeam Carpinus betulus - Easier to establish on heavy soils than beech. Leaves remain late on the plant.</p>
